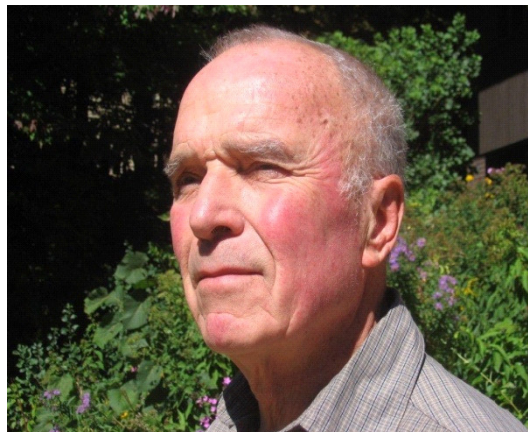
Lecture Series: Learning from the Past

Hans is a passionate speaker and has a wonderful collection of images, a slide show and fascinating stories. This lecture may influence your summer holiday plans.

Hans has visited hundreds of sites around the world. He has presented papers, established contacts with experts and in 1996 he evaluated a collection of petroglyph material for tax purposes for the Manitoba Museum.

His methodology has been studied by petroglyph centers in Italy, Sweden and Norway. He has also developed a keen interest in archaeoastronomy and has invented a small field instrument which determines the alignments of petroglyphs with the sun, structures or mountains to within 1°.
