

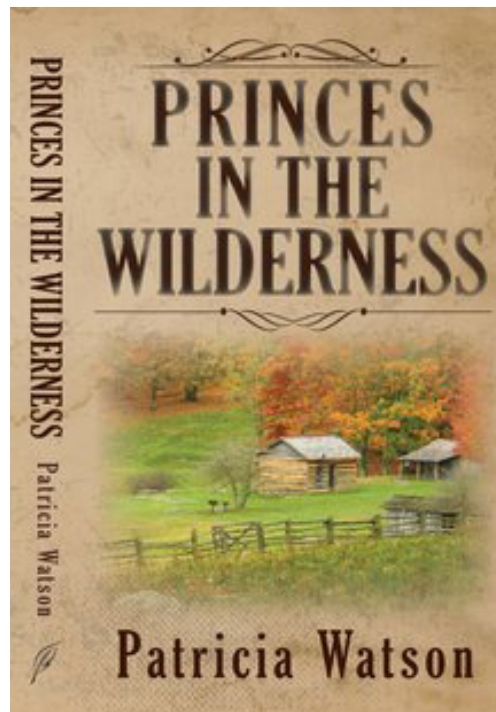

Her novel is based on the life of her great-great-grandfather, Thomas Dale, an original settler of South Simcoe County. Thomas and his siblings traveled from England to Newmarket where they carved out farms in the Holland Landing area just prior to the Upper Canada Rebellion of 1837.

Patricia has used her family's story to convey an important part of Canada's history from a local farmer's point of view.
