

A Sunday Visit to the neighbours!

A visit to inspire **dreams**: the King Township Historical Society **offers a tour** to the new **Whitchurch-Stouffville Museum and Community Centre**, an exciting design combining old and new buildings. We will tour a pioneer log cabin, a reconstructed post and beam barn, a charming Victorian farmhouse and a one-room schoolhouse originating in 1870 and since used briefly as a police station. New structural linkage provides airy exhibition space, catering facilities and meeting rooms, well integrated with the restored heritage structures. Careful thought was applied to make the most of the park-like site surrounded with leafy scenery. As a bright, busy centre of activities for all ages, no one can call this museum fusty. Come with us for an interesting afternoon!

We'll be treated to a history lesson about this neighbouring township where some of King's earlier generations went to school or did business via horse and buggy. **We will car pool from the King Museum parking lot at 1:00 to arrive for the 2 PM tour on Sunday, June 10.
